EXEMPTED BUSINESSES AND UNDERTAKINGS NO. 5

Pursuant to Order 5 (1) (m) of the Emergency Powers (Covid 19) (No. 2) Order, 2020 I HEREBY exempt the following businesses from the provisions of Order 5—

- (a) general insurance companies and brokers, to serve persons who do not have access to make electronic payments, specifically for the purpose of renewing auto insurance, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- (b) department of road traffic from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- (c) landscaping companies and persons contracted to maintain the road verges and public parks
 - (i) must operate in the open air; and
 - (ii) may operate between 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday and Sunday only.

Where possible, only essential workers necessary for the performance of the core functions of the businesses mentioned above are to be utilized, while adhering at all times to physical distancing requirements specified in the Order.
