The Ministry of Health reports today the following twenty-seven (27) unfortunate COVID-19 related deaths that were previously classified as deaths under investigation:

**IMPORTANT NOTES

The Ministry of Health reports today twenty-seven (27) COVID-19 related deaths from Grand Bahama over a period of five (5) months from the 16th April to 24th August, 2021. During this period some eighteen (18) females and seven (7) males succumbed to the COVID-19 virus. This means some 66.6% of these reported deaths were females and 33.3% were males. Remember, vaccination is our greatest defense to minimize deaths. Again the general public is encouraged to get vaccinated at the <u>earliest opportunity</u> - the life you safe may be your own.

The public is also reminded to remain vigilant, continue to wear a mask when not at home, wash hands frequently, stay physically distant, and remain at home if you do not have to go out.
