The Way Forward: A Plan for Recovery and Progress

This week the government will unveil the national budget for 2022/2023.

The theme of this year's budget is "The Way Forward: A Plan for Recovery and Progress."

The budget, which is the Davis Administration's first full fiscal communication, offers Bahamians a strategic roadmap for the coming year. The government remains focused on its promise to recover and rebuild the economy.

In the eight months since coming to office, the government has already provided a supplementary budget and a mid-year report that has reallocated government resources to prioritize immediate relief for the people and lay the foundation for economic recovery. The budget will continue to build on this foundation, charting a better way forward for the country.

Despite the historically challenging economic circumstances in the wake of Hurricane Dorian and the COVID-19 pandemic, the government's vision and plans for 'A New Day' remain on course to deliver on the holistic strategies outlined in its Blueprint For Change.

The Budget Communication will be presented in the House of Assembly on Wednesday, 25 May 2022 at 10 am.
