

Pinecrest is an affordable housing development on government land – south of Bamboo Boulevard in the growing population centre of southern New Providence. In Phase I, the project will consist of up to 47 homes. It is a project of the Ministry of Transport and Housing and is being introduced by the Minister of Transport and Housing, the Hon. JoBeth Coleby-Davis.

Pinecrest is a private-public partnership between Arawak Homes Limited and the Government of The Bahamas. Arawak Homes has been providing quality, affordable housing since 1983 and has built more houses for Bahamians than any other company in the history of The Bahamas.

The primary mortgage partner for Pinecrest is The Bahamas Mortgage Corporation. The Bahamas Mortgage Corporation was founded in 1983 by an act of Parliament and was created for Bahamians that need assistance in becoming homeowners.

- Construction started in January 2022
